

DonNTU's Delegation Visits South –Russian State Polytechnic University Named after Platov (Novocherkassk)

The delegation of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Donetsk People's Republic headed by the Deputy Minister Mr. M. Kushakov visited South-Russian State Polytechnic University named after Platov (SRSPU) in Novocherkassk on March 15th. Representatives of Donbass Academy of Construction and Architecture (DonNACA) and Donetsk National Technical University (DonNTU) were the delegation's member.



The Acting Rector Prof. Y. Razorenov, Vice-Rector on Research Prof. N. Gorbatenko, Vice Rector Prof. S. Chebotaryov, and Acting Director of the Institute of International Education Prof. G. Tokmakov participated in the meeting on behalf of SRSPU.

The representatives of DonNACA and DonNTU informed the Russian colleagues on educational and research potential of their institutions. They exchanged information on scientific schools, prospects of implementation of double-degree programs and getting Russian degrees at Novocherkassk partner-university according to the externship program. They also coordinated curricula and discussed development of the network cooperation in education and science, and mapped out further interaction and cooperation measures.

DonNTU's Representative Participates in the Round-Table Meeting “Ukraine's Ecocide: Consequences”

The LPR's capital hosted the international round-table “Ukraine's Ecocide: Consequences” on February 28th. The event was organized by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Ecological Safety and the Ministry of Education and Science of the LPR. It was presided over by the Deputy Chairman of the Council of Ministers Ms. N. Tikhonskaya. The representatives of the profile ministers, foreign journalists from Finland, the Netherlands and the USA, accredited in the LPR, key professionals of

the profile organizations, scientists from the LPR's universities and public figures participated in the round-table meeting.

Mr. A. Bondarenko, the Deputy Chairman of the State Committee on



Environmental Policy and Natural Resources and Prof. K. Marenich from DonNTU represented our Republic.

The goal of the event was to pay attention of the world public to Kiev government's actions aimed at destructing the economic space of the country which is accompanied by inevitable human toll, deterioration of life conditions, the environment, flora, and fauna degradation. Destruction of essential natural resources, catastrophic prospects of huge territories ecology which is characterized by such concept as "ecocide" is at issue. That is why it is crucial to define the ways to preserve industrial potential and natural resources of the Dobass People's Republics, to prevent our territories from plundering and the environment from degradation.

"Current destruction of the ecosystem on the territory of Ukraine is another manifestation of hybrid genocide of the Ukrainian nation. Not to allow Ukraine turning into a lifeless desert we should act together and use nonstandard methods. The main task of our round-table meeting is to develop the system of efficient resistance to the ecological aggression of Kiev. The Donbass People's Republics understand their responsibility for preserving the planet ecological balance. That is why they have a right to demand analogous actions from Kiev", stated Ms. Tikhonskaya.

Mr. Bondarenko informed on the aggressive information war organized against the DPR and the LPR. "In our turn, we have much to say to disprove false accusations", he said. He mentioned facts and numbers of the pernicious influence of neighbouring territory industries on the Donbass ecology because of incompetent

application of the environment protection technologies. First of all these are Kurakhovo and Ulegorsk thermal power stations, Mariupol metallurgical plants, Avdeevka by-product coke plant and Dzerzhinsk phenol plant.

Prof. K. Marenich paid participants' attention to the initiative of Kiev's authorities to start exploiting shale gas deposits to please their American masters. This predetermined catastrophic prospects of ecology of Donbass huge densely populated territories. It also made Ukraine use its army and air forces against the civilian population to create living unacceptable conditions and drive the people away from their native land in 2014.

The next initiative of the Kiev's authorities was the information injection on unavoidable ecological catastrophe caused by intensive mining. Prof. Marenich proved the inconsistency of the information injection using official statistics and research data. "The ecological situation connected with mining and pit closure has always been and is under control. Numerous specialized research institutions, profile companies, subdivisions of the Ministry of Emergency Situations established in Donetsk during all years of Donbass industry development solve the task of ecological risk prevention and the environment guaranteed protection", the professor emphasized.

The participants of the event noted that today Ukraine was the region in the state of ecological crisis and called all sensible forces and like-minded people to join and not to allow the ecological catastrophe on the territory as its consequences would have a negative effect on many generations of the people living on the South-East of Europe.

DonNTU Participates in Moscow Conference



Moscow hosted the international scientific and philosophical conference “E.I. Roerich’s Creative Commons and its Role in Science and Culture Development. Devoted to the 140th Anniversary” in March. Its organizers were St. Petersburg State Museum-Institute of the Roerichs, the International Charitable Foundation “Roerich’s Heritage” and the National Roerich Committee of the RF. Scientists from Russia, Germany, Austria, Australia, India, and Argentina participated in it.
