noted that this year the DPR and LPR educational institutions, in particular Donetsk National Technical University - students and teachers of the Faculty of Subsoil Management and Earth joined the teleconference. Also A. V. Titova and S. M. Mironov noted that despite the difficult time for Donbas, students and teachers of universities of the LDPR found an opportunity to participate in this event, and expressed hope for further fruitful cooperation.

The lecture given by S. M. Mironov was very informative, was accompanied by interesting facts from the biography and field work of the geologist.

These events have already become traditional; the next is planned for March this year, where our students and teachers will also take an active part.

Working Visit of Dean of Mining Faculty Dr. Korchevski to Islamic Republic of Iran

On the invitation of engineering company Kanikavan Shargh Engineering Co. (Islamic Republic of Iran, Pardiz, Technology Park) the Dean of the Faculty of Mining Donetsk National Technical University A.N. Korchevsky visited the Republic of Iran. During his stay, from 19 to 21 February, the work program included visits to industrial facilities: a coal association in Shahrode, a concentrating factory for processing of coal, a factory and mines waste bank, and a coal sludge settler. He also visited Kanikavan Shargh Engineering Co in Pardiz Technology Park, met Mr. Babak Barati, the Director General of Shahroud Coal Company, the Dean of the School of Mining Engineering of the Technical Institute of the University of Tehran, Dr Abbas Majdi, the Head of the Department of International Relations of the Polytechnic Institute of Tehran Mokmeli Mohammad.

In Paradiz (30 km from Tehran) a meeting with the scientific and technical staff headed by

the Technical Director Agha Zadeh was held at the IRI Technology Park. During the round table session, the directions of cooperation between DONNTU and the engineering company Kanikavan Shargh Engineering Co were discussed. Several issues concerning possible areas of joint activity for the implementation of applied and exploratory scientific research and development in the mining and metallurgical complex (IMC) were also considered. They also spoke on interdisciplinary research and development involving the extraction, processing and use of solid minerals; hydrocarbon extraction and transportation; GMC development strategy; ferrous and non-ferrous metal production; production of rare, rare earth metals; industrial processing of mining and chemical raw materials; oil and gas complex; production of nonmetallic and construction materials.

As a result of the meeting, a memorandum of bilateral cooperation was signed between DONNTU and the engineering company Kanikavan Shargh Engineering Co.

A meeting was held with Mr Mohammad Mokmeli, the Head of the International Relations Department of the Polytechnic Institute of the University of Tehran. He introduced the structure of the Polytechnic Institute of the University of Tehran, consisting of 11 faculties, the main ones being mining and metallurgical. There was also a discussion of the memorandum of cooperation needed to expand international relations of universities.

Dr. A. N. Korchevsky told about the history of DONNTU, presented a commemorative medal, issued for the 100th anniversary of the university, a monograph on embedding and briquetting of raw materials, as well as a textbook on flotation methods of enrichment of natural resources.

For the Dean of DONNTU an excursion on the laboratories of mechanical methods of testing samples of metals and alloys, vacuum casting of metals, magnetic enrichment methods was organized. The University of

Tehran has a transmission electron microscope for basic research. Its estimated value is \$1,000,000.

A meeting with the Dean of the School of Mining Engineering of the Technical Institute of the University of Tehran, Doctor Majdi Abbas to discuss a number of important issues related to joint research, exchange of specialists, preparation and publication of scientific works, internships, refresher courses, etc. was also held. The result was an agreement to develop additional areas of cooperation with DONNTU and the University of Tehran.

On the last day of the visit there was a working trip to the Shahrod region and a meeting with the Director General Babak Barati, who shared warm memories about the engineers of the Soviet Union (especially the miners of the Donbass), who built of mining and concentrating factories in Iran in the 1970s. In addition, there were discussions on possible technologies for processing technogeneous waste - rock piles of mines and concentrating factories, slurries. This task is relevant to the preservation of the ecological balance of the region. As to the future, the opinion on possible cooperation in this area was expressed.
