On April 16, on the basis of the Department of Economic Theory and Public Administration named after V.V. Dementyev and Department of Master of Public Administration, DonNTU hosted the XI International Scientific and Practical Conference “Modern Public and Municipal Administration: Issues, Technologies, Prospects”, held in

the remote and in person format. Co-organizers are the leading scientific and research educational

institutions: Economic Research Institute (Donetsk), Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation (Moscow), Lugansk State University named after Vladimir Dahl, Vernadsky Crimean Federal University (Simferopol), Tajik Technical University named after academician M.S. Osimi (Dushanbe), South-Ossetian State University named after A. Tibilov (Tskhinvali).

During the conference participants exchanged experience in the sphere of public and municipal administration, there were interesting discussions of the issues, principles and directions for the development of practice and technology of public administration.

The participants were greeted by the DonNTU's Rector Prof. A. Anoprienko, Professor of the Department of Public and Municipal Administration of the Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation Dr. N. Within the framework of the sections, the problems related to the theoretical and methodological foundations and organizational and managerial issues of the implementation of public administration, its scientific, methodological and information support, as well as innovative development of the state and regional economy were actively and fruitfully discussed.

As part of the breakout sessions, the participants heard speeches of the schoolchildren, students and postgraduates. In total, 119 scientific works were submitted at the conference.

Conference participants have studied neuromarketing technologies and their impact on consumers. Reports were delivered by Doctor of Economics Prof. I. Angelina, Doctor of Public Administration Prof. I. Kostenok, Doctor of Economics Prof. R. Lepa, Doctor of Economics Prof. V. Trubchanin, PhD in Economics, Assoc. Prof. Ye. Kurgan, PhD in Economics Ass. Prof. L. Strokina, PhD in Engineering Assoc. Prof. A. Kravchenko.

During the conference participants shared their experience and expertise, gained useful information to solve economic and managerial issues. At the end of the event, the results were summarized and the authors of the most interesting papers demonstrating their results of research were awarded prizes.

Mr. V. Falkov, Head of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation, noted that the creation of a network of youth design bureaus on the basis of universities is one of the effective tools to support engineering talents, launched on the instructions of the President of the Russian Federation Mr. V. Putin. *"The youth design bureaus are used to train highly qualified engineers capable of contributing to the country's technological leadership. In these bureaus, students, postgraduates and young scientists develop competitive technologies, solve specific scientific, technical and engineering problems, and are widely involved in the work on orders from industrial enterprises. It is important that the initiative has shown a high demand - 178 universities from 81 regions of the country applied for the first competition. 15 winning universities will receive support for the creation of new and development of existing sites, including the purchase of modern equipment,"* – the minister said.

The representatives of DonNTU and Automobile and Road Institute DonNTU's branch won 5 million rubles grant support in the direction of "Creation and development of student design bureau".

The DonNTU's Rector Prof. A. Anoprienko noted: *"The competition was very serious. At the beginning of April, the finalists of the competition defended in person their projects to create SDB before the Commission of the Ministry of Education and Science in Moscow. I am proud that the project of our student design bureau was highly appreciated. I am sure that all the students of DonNTU and its Gorlovka branch will actively start working on the projects of our industrial partners and their own developments in our "Donetsk Universal" Student Design Bureau"*.



DonNTU Holds VI All-Russian Scientific and Practical Conference “Tools of Project Management and Data Analysis in Decision Support Systems”



The conference covered the issues of advanced methods of project-based learning in the field of process management in the field of digital data design. Chairman of DonNTU SMU – Participant of the Working Meeting of Young Scientists of the South of Russia in Rostov-on-Don



DonNTU’s Student – Shortlisted Candidate of Online Round of Russian Cup for Programming Unmanned Aircraft Systems “Parma-BAS”

From March 24 to March 30, the qualifying online round of the Russian Cup for Programming Unmanned Aircraft Systems (“Parma-BAS”) was held, attended by 207 people from 36 regions of Russia. “Parma-BAS” is annual All-Russian competitions dedicated to the development of control algorithms for groups of unmanned vehicles.

The participants of the competition were divided into two groups: student division (157 people) and professional division (50 people).

The student division included full-time students of higher educational institutions of engineering and natural sciences, who are able to program a UAV for autonomous flight in changing conditions. Age – 17–25 years old.

The professional division – graduates, employees of technology companies and scientific labs, who are designing unmanned technologies, or who are just keen enthusiasts without age limits.

The competitions were conducted with the domestic flight simulator Geoscan. The main tasks were:

- promotion of sport programming among the country's population;
- broadening of sports relations;
- improving of sportsmanship;
- identifying promising sportsmen for creation of the reserve of Russian national team of students;
- increasing the prestige and attraction of IT-field in the eyes of youth of the country.

The student of the Faculty of the Information Systems and Technology of Donetsk National Technical University Ivan Sygin (gr. IS-21) has long been interested in this kind of sports programming and took part in these competitions. His task was to compile a location map using the unmanned vehicle and to determine the way of car movement from a given point to a destination.

On April 03, the results of the qualifying round were announced. Ivan Sygin has successfully completed the task and became a finalist, winning IV place in the professional division.

DonNTU Students - Winners of IV All-Russian Competition on History of Entrepreneurship “Legacy of Outstanding Entrepreneurs of Russia”
