DonNTU's Rector Prof. Anoprienko signed a collaboration agreement with Kazakhstan National Academy of Mining on April 27th. The President of the Academy Mr. Ryspanov signed the agreement on April 22nd on the initiative of both the Academy and the Mining Faculty of

DonNTU. It is significant that the document was signed on the eve of the university's centenary.

Kazakhstan mining is one of the most numerous and representative science branches. Mining and metallurgical industries of the country are its foundation. It includes thousands of companies. VII International Scientific Forum of Donetsk People's Republic "Innovative Prospects of Donbass: Infrastructural, Social and Economic Development" at DonNTU

DonNTU hosted the VII International Scientific Forum of the Donetsk People's Republic "Innovative Prospects of Donbass: Infrastructural, Social and Economic Development" on May 24th. Its main organizer was the Ministry of Education and Science of the DPR. The event was aimed at discussing the state policy tasks in scientific and technical development, scientific and business cooperation mechanism formation, definition of the most important trends in science, technologies and innovations, and priorities to provide Donbass sustainable development and social and economic efficiency raise.



Representatives of ministries and agencies, key scientific and educational institutions of the DPR, the RF, the LPR, Belarus and Kazakhstan were the participants of the event. They made their face-to-face and online presentations there.

There was a traditional exhibition of scientific and technical developments made by young researchers of the country at the History Museum of DonNTU before the forum. Demonstration of all the displays was accompanied by the music played by the string quartet of Donetsk State Music Academy named after S. Prokofiev. Many of the represented works are of practical importance. All the displays were prepared by students of DonNTU, DonNACA, DonFTI named after A. Galkin, and schoolchildren from Donetsk Republican Centre for Technological Creativity. The Minister of Education and Science of the DPR Mr. M. Kushakov handed diplomas to young winners. He also mentioned the upcoming jubilee of DonNTU (its centenary) which will be celebrated in late May. The university is the main forge of engineers in

our industrial region. The exhibitions like this one help to specify how far we moved in development of the engineering thought and innovations. There are prize winners of some technological creativity contests held in Russia among the winners of this event. The minister also emphasized the importance of the achievements made by children as they are the future of the Republic.

There was an exhibition “DonNTU’s History in Phaleristics” organized by university’s graduate of 1973 V. Zakharov in the frameworks of the event.

The forum was opened in the assembly hall of the 9th university building. The guests were met by the brass band of Donetsk Musical School # 1. The musicians played DonNTU’s anthem.

DonNTU’s Rector Prof. A. Anoprienko opened the forum: “The current year was announced the Year of Science and Technologies in the Russian Federation. This year is a jubilee one for us and also the year of university’s accreditation in Russia. We see that innovation prospects are gaining their momentum”.

Mr. Kushakov said that the state paid much attention to engineering education development despite the current war conditions. Engineers are of great demand in Donbass. He wished DoNTU new interesting inventions and achievements. Representatives of DPR’s ministries and boards also greeted the forum participants. DonNTU’s Rector thanked the People’s Council of the DPR for its assistance in repairing students’ hostels and university buildings facades.

The final meeting of the forum took place in the Donetsk Botanical Garden on May 26th. The memorial lane devoted to DonNTU’s centenary laid in April was opened.

Prof. Anoprienko greeted the participants. In his speech he said there had been 5 events in the frameworks of the forum in 2015, and in the year of DonNTU’s centenary and 300th anniversary of Donbass there had been 27 of them so far. Their level has been extremely high.



The Vice –Rector in research Prof. S. Borshchevski accentuated strengthening and widening of the international links of DonNTU. The Mining Faculty’s Dean Prof. Korchevski had visited Teheran. The collaboration agreement between DonNTU and Teheran Polytechnic University is being prepared now to be signed.

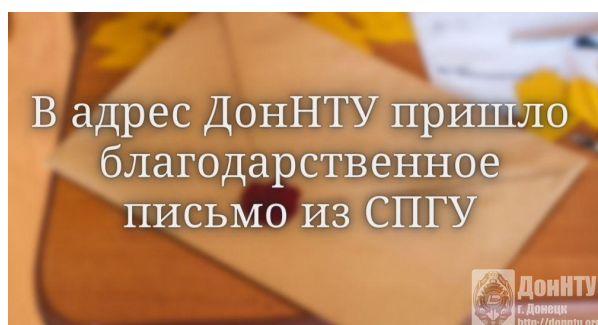
Dr. Litvinski from Donbass State Technical University (Alchevsk), DonNTU’s graduate, greeted the audience during university’s 40th anniversary and now!

Professors from High School of Economics of the University of Lisbon (Portugal), Economic University of Katowice (Poland), and the University of Trento Italo Trevizan (Italy) organized master-classes for the participants.



DonNTU's Teacher Conquers Western Caucasus

Dr. O. Cherednikova spends May holidays in the mountains as a member of different tourist groups. She has been doing it for 10 years. This year she has got an invitation from the Federation of Sport Tourism of the DPR and joined the first complexity degree mountain tour along the Western Caucasus.



The Caucasus in spring is not very popular because of frequent snowfalls, avalanches and changeable weather. That is why there were only four members in the team. All of them are DonNTU's graduates of different years, three of whom are working in IT sphere. So they have decided to raise the Computer

Technologies Faculty's flag and take pictures against Caucasus landscapes.

Their route was from Teberda to Arkhyz and included conquering of three passes. The first of them – Mukha (2764m) was conquered frontally to avoid going on snow. It made the rise more difficult but less dangerous. The mountain tourists raised the Faculty's flag on the pass.

It was raining when the tourists were rising on Kyzylaush pass (2900 m) and then it started snowing. The snowdrifts were knee-high, so the people had to go in their

footsteps during 90 minutes without any halts. There was strong wind which prevented them from raising the flag, so they had to go down the valley. They managed to overcome the third pass called SAO (Special Astrophysical Observatory) despite some difficulties.

DonNTU Takes Part in Russian-German Raw Materials Forum

The Russian-German Raw Materials Forum took place on the Zoom platform on April 29-30. Prof. Borshchevski, Prof. Labinski, and Prof. Korchevski took part in it. The forum is an important platform to discuss prospects of Russian-German collaboration in the field of energy and raw materials and to initiate bilateral projects. This year the priority topics were climate protection, energy new sources, structural changes and digitization, and development of the Russian-German partnership in the sphere of sustainable development.

Members of the Russian and German governments and representatives of the companies “Gazprom”, “VNG AG”, “Siemens Energy AG”, Sibur Holding”, “Novatec” and key expert and scientific centres of both countries made their presentations at the event.



The program included discussions in the format of round table meetings for working groups.

The event participants emphasized the importance of development of collaboration in the sphere of development and supply of energy traditional sources with application of efficient advanced technologies.
